

Basic Serging Techniques

Students should bring:

- Serger and accessories
(don't forget your foot pedal and power cord)
- Operation manual for you machine
- Serger needles in size 11 and 14 and Knit or jersey needles
- Scissors
- Pencil/pen and notebook
- Additional light if needed

Beginning Quilting

Saturday August 2 from 10:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

This class covers basic rotary cutting, machine piecing, and pressing techniques. A 9" star block will be made in class from kits provided. The class stresses accuracy in cutting and seaming to achieve the finished square.

Students should have a basic working knowledge of their sewing machine.

Students should bring:

- Sewing machine and accessories (don't forget your foot pedal, power cord and bobbins)
- Operation manual for you machine
- Needles – size 12
- Cotton thread in ecru or natural
- Scissors
- Rotary cutter with a fresh blade (45mm suggested)
- Ruler to go with your cutter (6" x 12" minimum 12" x 12" or 16" x 16" suggested)
- Pencil/pen and notebook
- Additional lighting and operation manual for you machine if needed

The block featured can be finished into a pillow top or additional blocks can be made to complete a 9-block quilt top. Measurements for either finishing technique will be provided. Additional kits will be for sale the day of the class.

This is a one-day class. Follow-up classes and other classes will be scheduled as requested and suggested (sashing , borders, machine quilting, hand quilting and bindings)

We will explore waistlines, hems, and sleeves. Knowing when to adjust or donate a garment can save aggravation. Making the adjustments yourself saves money.
